NOTICE OF RACE**

The Organizing Authority of the Regatta "Danish Herring Pre Grade One Dragon Cup 2017" and "Marblehead Trophy 2017" is Dragør Sejlklub, Strandlinien 1 B, 2791 Dragør, www.dragoer-sejlklub.dk

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, except as changed by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 The applying prescriptions of the Nordic Sailing Federation and the Danish Sailing Association is incorporate into the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 The crew weight restriction in class rule 13.30 will apply.
- 1.4 The rules are changed as follows:
 - Rules 35, A4 and A5 is change to state, that boats failing to finish within 30minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will score Did Not Finish.
 - Rules 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
 - Rules 61.3 and 62.2 is change to fix the protest time to 60 minutes for competitors, the protest committee as well as the race committee.
 - Rule 61.1(b) is change so protests by race committee and protest committee will be posted on the official notice board.
 - Rule 62.1(a) is change so failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress.
 - Rule 62.2 is change to shorten the time limit for a request for redress from a protest committee decision on the last scheduled day racing.
 - Rule A4 is change by stating, that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will score Did Not Start.

The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising is limited to Category A.
- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open for all owners of Dragons, who hold valid Measurement Certificates.
- 3.2 For the Marblehead Trophy only one boat from each yacht club can participate.
- 3.3 Participants must comply with the eligibility prescriptions in the Class Rules.
 - All skippers and boat owners must be up to date members of their national Dragon Class Association.



- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by forwarding information to Regatta Manager Mik Jensen at mail mj@lfst.dk at latest 18 August 2017. It shall be specific announce weather a boat is racing for the Marblehead Trophy or not.
- 3.4 A boat is not registered until the entry fee is paid.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Entry fee: DKK 1.200 (Euro 160).
- The fee include: Launching, dock space, trailer storage, hauling out, after racing beer and snacks all days, breakfast and do it yourself lunch.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.1 Registration: Thursday 24 August 16.00 to 19.00 and Friday 25 August 07.00-9.00 at the Regatta Office in Dragør Sejlklub.
- 5.1 Sailing: Warning Signal for the first race Friday, Saturday and Sunday at 11.00 hrs. Friday, Saturday and Sunday as many races as possible.
- 5.3 After finishing a race, a new race will start as soon as possible.
- 5.4 Friday and Saturday no warning signal after 16.00 hrs.
- 5.5 On the last day of the regatta, no warning signal after 14.00 hrs.
- 5.6 Social activities: A cocktail party is expected to take place Saturday 26 August.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate and present it at registration.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 Preliminary sailing instructions will be available on the regatta website www.dragoer-sejlklub.dk from 18 August 2017. Final sailing instructions will be available at registration.

8 VENUES

- 8.1 The regatta harbour will be Dragør Havn.
- 8.2 Courses will be sailed on the waters south of Peberholm approx. 3 nm east of Dragør.

9 THE COURSE

- 9.1 The courses will be "Windward/Leeward courses".
- 9.2 The planned sailing time for the first boat will be 60 minutes.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of race scored, when 5 or more races have been completed, at boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.2 Winner of the Marblehead Trophy will be according to the results after the races accomplished Friday and Saturday and without any discard never mind the number of races accomplished.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

- 11.1 Support boats, coaches and other support personnel shall be registered at the Race Office within the registration time (see schedule).



11.2 Support boats shall display their national flag together with a white board displaying the sail number of the related boat(-s). Minimum size of the board is 40 cm x 50 cm.

12 LAUNCHING AND HAULING

Crane for launching will be available at the harbour Thursday 16.00 – 20.00 and Friday 7.00 – 9.00 hrs. and for hauling out Sunday after racing.

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats may not be hauled out during the regatta, except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. The race committee intends to use an open VHF radio channel for information about the starts, recalls etc.

15 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded on a ratio of one per each five boats.
Prize giving will take place soonest possible after racing on the Sunday.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.
The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of DKK 16.000.000 per event or the equivalent.
